CDC 2013-2014 season to include: Little Shop Of Horrors, Dear Edwina, Spring Awakening, and The Graduate.

The Cranford Dramatic Club (CDC) Community Theatre announces their 2013-2014 season: Little Shop Of Horrors, Dear Edwina, Spring Awakening, and The Graduate.

In Little Shop Of Horrors (Book by Howard Ashman, Music by Alan Menken, Lyrics by Howard Ashman, based on the film by Roger Corman) a floral assistant becomes an overnight sensation when he discovers an exotic plant with a mysterious craving for fresh blood. One of the longest-running Off-Broadway shows of all time, this affectionate spoof of 1950s sci-fi is charming, tuneful and hilarious, with tongue firmly planted in cheek. Our Fall production will be directed by Alan Van Antwerp.

Dear Edwina (Book by Marcy Heisler, Music by Zina Goldrich, Lyrics by Marcy Heisler) is a heartwarming musical about the joys of growing up. Thirteen year-old Edwina Spoonapple would do just about anything to be a part of the Kalamazoo Advice-a-palooza Festival. When a talent scout from the convention visits her hometown, she trots out her musical advice giving shows live from the family garage in hopes of finding her place in the spotlight. The Children's Production will be directed by Megan Ferentinos.

Spring Awakening (Book and Lyrics by Steven Sater, Music by Duncan Sheik, Based on the play by Frank Wedekind), winner of 8 Tony Awards, is a rock musical adaptation of Frank Wedekind's 1891 expressionist play about the trials and tribulations, and the exhilaration of the teen years. Spring Awakening explores the confusion and desperation that ensue when the onrushing tide of hormones meets the ignorance of children. Our Winter production will be directed by Jeffrey Fiorello.

The Graduate (Buck Henry, Terry Johnson, Charles Webb, Calder Willingham), a hit in the West End and a popular show on Broadway starring Kathleen Turner, brings the inspired movie of the Sixties vividly to life on stage. Benjamin Braddock, recent college graduate and prodigal son, returns home and promptly becomes embroiled in an affair with the wife of his father's business partner, one Mrs. Robinson, but soon finds himself falling in love with her daughter, Elaine. Our Spring production will be directed by Greg Louis.
